CLASSES

- #1. Walk/Trot Trail
- #2. Walk/Trot Rail
- #3. Walk/Trot Riding (Pattern)
- #4. Conformation Horses 10 yo and under
- #5. Walk/Trot/Lope Trail
- #6. Walk/Trot/Lope Rail
- #7. Walk/Trot/Lope Riding (Pattern)
- #8. Conformation Horses 11 yo and over

RULES

- 1. No Cross Over entries between walk/Trot and Walk/Trot/Lope
- 2. **No Stallions**
- 3. **Stabling**
 - a. Priority given to those that stay for the Mountain Trail Show
 - b. Stalls must be stripped before leaving
- 4. Haul ins accepted but must be entered in at least one class. Do not tie to trailers if horse paws. Horses may not be tied to trailer overnight.
- 5. Dogs must be on leash and not allowed around arenas. You must clean up after your dog.
- 6. All youth, 18 years and under) must wear **a helmet.**
- 7. Show management reserves the right to cancel, transfer or reschedule the show and/or classes without notice or liability. In the event of the cancellation of classes, refund will be issued.
- 8. AQHA rules apply except for the following (9)
- 9. **Reins:**
 - a. A rider may ride two-handed only with a hackamore/bosal or loose ring snaffle on any age horse.
 - b. Any rider using a shank bit must ride one-handed. One hand to be around reins when romal type reins are used, index finger only between split reins is also permitted
 - c. Riding two-handed in a shank bit will result in disqualification in any class.
 - d. In ranch trail, it is permissible to change hands to work an obstacle.
- 10. Warm up will be available in the warm arena.
- 11. Please follow basic biosecurity protocols including ensuring your horses' vaccinations are current, distancing horses, not putting hose nozzles inside of buckets and not allowing horses to drink from communal water sources or other peoples unattended buckets.
- 12. If tack is deemed unsuitable or unsafe by management or judges it cannot be used.
